Tour Overview

An optional side tour to Tromsø is also possible.

Travel Arrangements

Tour participants are responsible for arranging their own flights:

- From home to Trondheim,
- From Trondheim to Bergen, or Tromsø (optional),
- From Tromsø to Bergen (if taking the optional tour), and
- Return flight home from Bergen.

- Site tours will be by chartered motor coach or other appropriate ground transportation.
